Administration

The Markets at Olive project located at Olive and 170 began night work on Monday, September 13th. Earth-moving activities will occur day and night, and precautions will be taken to keep the dust down. These activities are expected to occur for 40 days and will consist of taking dirt from the new Costco site to the old emergency care facility that was located south of Olive.

Police Department (UCPD)

Public Works

Paper Shredding Event is scheduled for Saturday, September 18 from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. at the Centennial Commons (Recreation Center) parking lot located at 7210 Olive Blvd. There is a limit of 5 (five) bankers' boxes per car.

Residential Street Sweeping begins in the West area on Monday, September 20 and will be performed in that work week. This service is intended to reduce the materials entering the sewer system and improve the appearance and cleanliness of City streets. Please do use residential driveways as available for parking during the week in the service area in order for the department to conduct an effective street sweeping.

City-wide Bulk Item Collection begins in the Central area on Monday, September 20 and will be performed in that work week. Accepted bulk items include furniture and appliances. Electronics will no longer be accepted in the bulk item collection. Participating residents are asked to place no more than 3 large items or 7 smaller items within 1-3 feet of curb or street pavement for collection.

Fall Curbside Leaf Collection is coming up! This season's work is scheduled to begin in the East area in the work week starting on Monday, November 1, 2021. We ask that our residents rake their leaves to the curb line between the Friday before collection begins in your area and Monday 7 AM of your collection week. The truck will make only one pass per household. Please do not mix other yard waste (gumballs, trash, small tree branches/limbs, brush, grass clippings, etc.) in with leaves and continue using the yard waste collection service for the disposal of other yard waste and contact the department office at (314) 505-8560 with any questions.

- Responsible for monthly/annual storage fees
- Must register in the University City Camera Program

Eligibility:
For University City residents and residential properties only. The Participant must be the owner of the property for more than one year. The participant must provide proof of ownership and occupancy.
