### **FORSYTH BOULEVARD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

The City of University City has a contract with Gershenson Construction for Road Improvements on Forsyth Boulevard from Big Bend to Clayton City limits. Project includes sidewalk and curb ramp upgrades, road resurfacing, traffic signal upgrades and bicycle facilities pavement markings. We will start the project completing sidewalk and curb ramp repairs starting at Big Bend and working to Clayton on the North side of the road. Sidewalks will be completed in sections. Areas will be from Big Bend to Asbury, Asbury to Manhattan, Manhattan to Clayton City Limits. When we are working on the sidewalk in these areas there will be No Parking posted. We will keep the opposite parking lane open but traffic will be narrowed during the day in our work area. After we finish the north side of Forsyth we will turn around and complete the south side with the same work areas. Our superintendent will contact each homeowner with a letter when we are removing sidewalk thru your driveway.

After we are finished with the concrete sidewalks and HC Ramps, Forsyth will be milled and deteriorated areas will be removed and replaced with asphalt. After pavement reconstruction is complete Forsyth will be asphalt overlaid then new pavement markings.

Anticipated start of this project is July 23rd and finish by the end of November, weather permitting. If you have any questions, please call me.
