CALOP Purpose:

Responsible for studying the educational and cultural programming needs of University City and encouraging development of programming that meets those needs.

CALOP Membership:

- 7 voting members Appointed by Council
- 3 non-voting Ex-Officio members
 - Councilmember
 - University City School District
 - Higher Education Consortium of Metro St. Louis

CALOP Funding:

- Shall operate on City's fiscal year
- Able to issue grants
- Power to collect, hold, manage funds appropriated to CALOP.

CALOP Responsibilities:

Draft a 5 year plan for the educational and cultural cablecasting programming goals and objectives for the City. CALOP shall have a public hearing before and after drafting the five (5) year plan and shall submit the plan to the Council for comment.
