The Historic Preservation Commission meeting scheduled for February 18 was cancelled.

Parks, Recreation and Forestry

Senior Commission – At the February 16, 2021 meeting the Senior Commission was updated on the status of the Centennial Commons, Community Center and Heman Park Pool closures and the City’s plans to reopen Centennial Commons and the Heman Park Pool in the spring. The Commission also elected Ms. Gloria Nickerson as President.

Parks Commission – At the February 16, 2021 meeting the Parks Commission approved the Commissions Capital Improvement Priorities for Parks. Reviewed and discussed the Park Rules and Regulations that were supported by the Commission in September of 2019, as well as proposed changes to Park related ordinances. The Commission also approved to support the donation of picnic tables for Heman Park – Community Center.

Public Works

Spring Curbside Leaf Collection is coming up! This season’s work is scheduled to begin in the East area in the work week starting on Monday, March 1, 2021. We ask that our residents rake their leaves to the curb line between the Friday before collection begins in your area and Monday 7 AM of your collection week. The truck will make only one pass per household. Please do not mix other yard waste (gumballs, trash, small tree branches/limbs, brush, grass clippings, etc.) in with leaves and continue using the yard waste collection service for the disposal of other yard waste and contact the department office at (314) 505-8560 with any questions.

No stickers are required for collection of yard waste until further notice.

A Service Line Warranties of America (SLWA) program is offered to property owners in University City to help with the expense of needed repairs to residential sewer lateral lines.
