Administration

On Thursday, March 4, 2021, at 7 p.m., Mayor Crow and I are scheduled to deliver the State of the City Address. The presentations will be broadcast via zoom and on YouTube. On behalf of Mayor Crow and myself, I want to thank the Historical Society for inviting us to speak and sponsoring this event.

The Mayor and Council during their meeting on Monday discussed the need for an organization to provide a waiver and insurance to use the ballfields. The Mayor and Council decided to seek a recommendation from the Parks Commission, who will meet on Tuesday, March 2, 2021 at 6:30 p.m., to discuss the issue. The Parks Commission will hold a zoom meeting.

During the study session on Monday, the Mayor and Council received a presentation on the proposed economic development strategy from the I5 Group. There were no major changes requested. The proposed economic development strategy is tentatively scheduled to be placed on the March 22, 2021 regular Council meeting agenda for consideration.
