### City Manager's Office

Costco Development Advancing:

All the properties needed for the construction of the Costco at Olive and I170 were purchased this week by Costco. As a result of the sale, we have received \$3 million to use on improvements in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Ward. Over the next days, we will be working with the developer to construct a calendar of events that I intend to make public.

### Fire Department (UCFD)

Reminder - University City Fire Department will begin giving Covid vaccine shots to homebound residents of University City. Residents must still call the St. Louis County Public Health to register and be screened. The contact number is [314-615-2660](tel:314-615-2660). Once you have been screened and accepted, you will be contacted by UCFD personnel to set up an appointment time.

The vaccine will be the Johnson & Johnson shot, which is a single vaccine. No follow up shot will be needed.

### Public Works

City-wide Bulk Item Collection is coming up! This season's work is scheduled to begin in the East area on Monday, April 12, 2021 and will be performed in that work week. Accepted bulk items include furniture and appliances. Electronics will no longer be accepted in the bulk item collection. Participating residents are asked to place no more than 3 large items or 7 smaller items within 1-3 feet of curb or street pavement for collection.

No stickers are required for collection of yard waste until further notice.

## Planning & Development

The City of University City is pleased to announce Round 4 of the Forgivable Loan Small Business Assistance Program. The City has earmarked \$700,000.00 for the Program that is intended to help eligible local retail, service and creative for-profit businesses address immediate cash for short-term financial operational needs such as payroll, payment to suppliers, payment to service providers or payment of utilities. The available funding is intended to serve all qualified University City businesses with a goal that at least 25% of the allocated funding will fund minority and women-owned businesses. The loan funds may not be used for capital expenditures or rent. The intent of this Program is to provide local businesses relief due to their economic loss during the current COVID-19 Pandemic. Applications will be accepted through April 30, 2021.
