BURGLARY PREVENTION

Lock all windows and doors, including interior garage doors, storm doors, and sliding doors

Keep fences closed and locked. Lock all entry gates with a padlock

Secure spare keys safely. Keep spares keys away from exterior windows, doors, and lock-boxes

Turn on exterior lights

Install an alarm system. Use audible or monitored alarm systems and place the company's sign in your front and back yard



Install deadbolts to all entry doors

Trim trees and bushes. Keep bushes and tree branches trimmed away from windows

Remove objects in yard that could be used to make forced entry

Get to know your neighbors! Neighbors that watch out for each other. Create neighborhoods criminals tend to leave alone
