## Public Works

City-wide Bulk Item Collection will begin in the East area on Monday, April 11, 2022 and will be performed in that work week. Accepted bulk items include furniture and appliances. Electronics will no longer be accepted in the bulk item collection. Participating residents are asked to place no more than 3 large items or 7 smaller items within 1-3 feet of curb or street pavement for collection.

A Commission on Storm Water Issues regular monthly meeting was held on Tuesday, April 5. The Commission approved motions to recommend funding and installation of flood planks at 8436 and 8444 Old Bonhomme Road properties and also to recommend overall funding for flood mitigation projects in University City. The project will be forwarded to Metropolitan Sewer District for consideration. The Commission also heard an update on the Army Corps Study and Flood Early Warning Systems.

A Traffic Commission regular monthly meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, April 13 at 6:30 p.m. The meeting will be hosted on Zoom.

A Green Practices Commission regular monthly meeting is scheduled for Thursday, April 14 at 5:30 p.m. The meeting will be hosted at the Heman Park Community Center.
