Public Works

Please watch for a survey in the mail that intends to collect our citizens' input on the stormwater needs and concerns. The survey can be filled out in ink and mailed back/dropped off at the University City Public Works department, filled out online or the information can also be called in to a designated phone messaging system. The properties that are in the 100-year floodplain will receive additional questions in their survey pertaining to that; however, the citizen response to those questions can be made using the same methods as above.

City-wide Bulk Item Collection is in progress! The work is scheduled to begin in the Central area on Monday, April 18, 2022 and will be performed in that work week. Accepted bulk items include furniture and appliances. Electronics will no longer be accepted in the bulk item collection. Participating residents are asked to place no more than 3 large items or 7 smaller items within 1-3 feet of curb or street pavement for collection.

A Traffic Commission regular monthly meeting was held on Wednesday, April 13. The Commission approved a motion to allow a Residential Parking Permit petition to be initiated on the south side of Forsyth Blvd. in the 7000 and 7100 blocks.
