Police Department (UCPD)

The University City Police Department, in collaboration with the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), will be offering the public an opportunity to safely dispose of expired, unused, and unwanted prescription drugs.

The collection will take place on April 30th from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m. at Millbrook Pharmacy, 7010 Pershing Ave., University City, MO 63130. The service is free and anonymous.

Please note, for safety reasons, the DEA will only accept pills or patches. They cannot accept liquids, needles, or sharps. (see Attachment 1)

Public Works

Please watch for a survey in the mail that intends to collect our citizens' input on stormwater needs and concerns. The survey can be filled out in ink and mailed back/dropped off at the University City Public Works department, filled out online or the information can also be called in to a designated phone messaging system. For properties that are in the 100-year floodplain' there are additional questions in the survey.

Residential Street Sweeping will be performed in the West area in the work week beginning on Monday, May 2, 2022. This service is intended to reduce the materials entering the sewer system and improve the appearance and cleanliness of City streets. Please do use residential driveways as available for parking during the week in the service area in order for the department to conduct an effective street sweeping.

Stickers will be required for collection of yard waste beginning on July 1, 2022.

A Commission on Storm Water Issues regular monthly meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, May 3 at 6:30 p.m. The meeting will be hosted at the Heman Park Community Center.
