# You can survive an **ACTIVE SHOOTER**

If you find yourself in harm's way, take fast and decisive action.

## **RUN**



If a safe path is available, **RUN:**

- Do not hesitate; get out
- Leave your belongings
- Prevent others from entering the area
- Call 911 when you are safe

## **HIDE**



If you can't get out safely, **HIDE:**

- Stay out of the shooter's view and be quiet.
- Silence your phone
- Lock / barricade doors
- Call 911 if it is safe to do so

## **FIGHT**



As a last resort, **FIGHT:**

- Fight with full commitment
- Be physically aggressive
- Use improvised weapons
- Fight to incapacitate the shooter



Run - Hide - Fight are an arsenal of tools, not a chronological progression of response.
