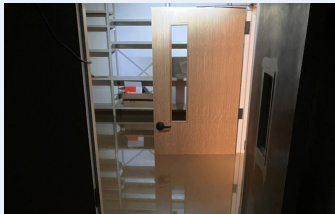


BIG BEND TRAFFIC
