



## Canton Phase I Street Improvement Project



The Canton Avenue Phase I Improvement Project is a road improvement project that is federally funded through the Surface Transportation Program. The project includes construction of new sidewalks; removal and replacement of the sidewalks; driveway approaches, curb and gutter replacement; curb ramps, ADA compliance and road resurfacing. The project runs along Canton Avenue in-between Hanley Road and North and South Road and is expected to be completed in September 2023.




