Proposition M - April 4 Election

On Tuesday, Apr. 4, University City voters will vote on Proposition M. Prop M allows for a 3% sales tax on retail marijuana sales within University City, Revenue generated from Prop M may go towards public safety and youth drug education programs. Currently, there are two marijuana dispensaries in University City. The City of St. Louis and 35 St. Louis County Municipalities are voting on Prop M on Apr. 4.
