

VIPS Eligibility:

- Must be a United States citizen
- Must have a valid Missouri driver's license
- Must have not received excessive traffic citations in the last 3 years
- Must be at least 21 years of age and live in the City of University City
- Must have successfully completed the University City Police Citizen's Academy
- Must successfully undergo a background check by the department, including fingerprint submission to MSHP
- Must complete an interview w/ selected members of the VIPS Program and sworn members of the department.
