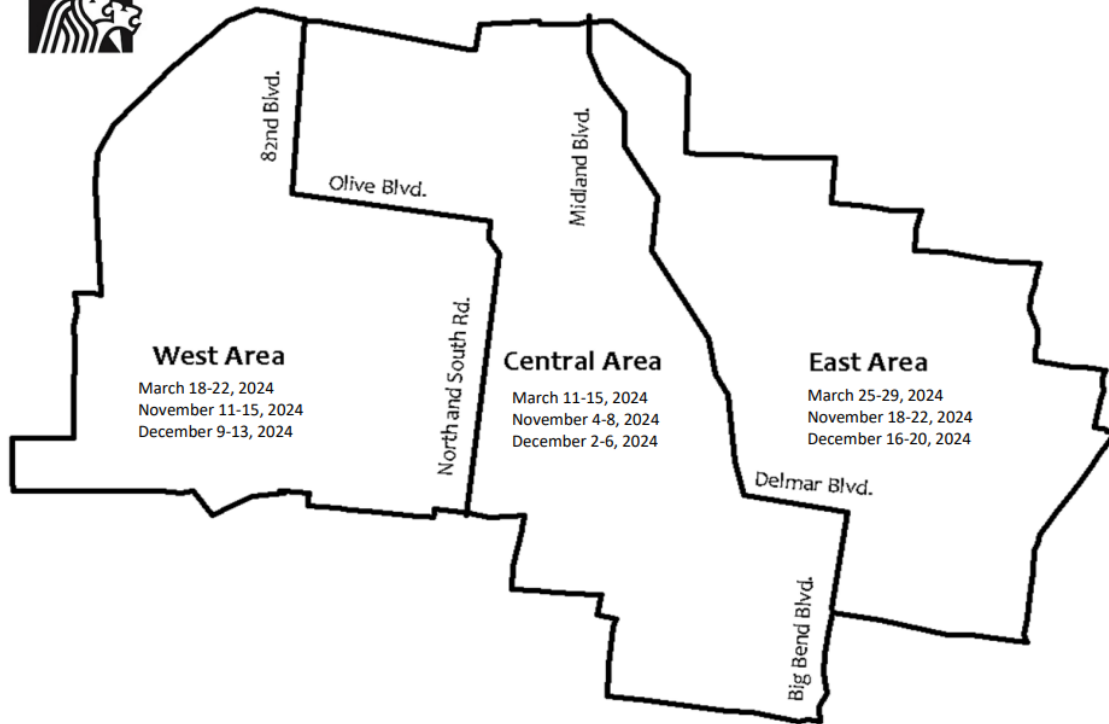


ELECTION JUDGES NEEDED

In addition to many volunteers and runners who have participated in the event for most of those 50 years, there also are families with three generations of runners including parents, children and now grandchildren.

The history of the race started in 1974 when it was begun by the Special Events Commission, a City board whose charge was creating community-wide events. Over the years, it evolved into one of the most successful and enduring events, with profits supporting various community groups.
