Eclipse Glasses Recycling

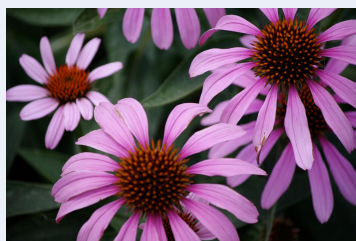
The School District of University City will be recycling undamaged viewing glasses for other students across the globe to use in the future.
