## FEMA Restoration Work Set for Completion this Summer



In late January 2024, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) approved reimbursement for repairs in University City stemming from the devastating July 2022 flooding that inflicted significant damage upon Centennial Commons, the Central Garage, and associated facilities, along with the Heman Park Community Center. Following an open bidding process in March, a contractor was selected, and substantial completion is anticipated to be achieved by the end of August.




