


REPORT A NUISANCE

Work Underway on Annex and Trinity Building Renovations

Following a groundbreaking ceremony August 1, work has begun on the Annex and Trinity Building renovations to be renovated into a state-of-the-art Police Department and Fire Department headquarters. The City Services Group is currently conducting asbestos and asbestos removal starting with the Annex building. Abatement on both buildings will be completed by the end of this year with permanent renovations to begin in early 2025. The Annex will be open to the public for both meetings in March 2026.

The Annex, built in 1904, was originally a 5,120 square foot building used as the University City Public Library for nearly 60 years until the 1950s. The Annex, built in 1903, is a two-story, 10,000 square foot building that served as the City's first police station and firehouse. The Annex and Trinity built in 1904 were the first buildings to be built in the City of University City.

The active construction site will impact parking at City Hall and Municipal Lot 4 used for overflow parking. There is no cost to park in Municipal Lot 4.

GUEST ADMISSION

Those with a valid Fall "Thank You" or Monthly Flood Pass may bring in guests to Centennial Commons. The membership holder must be 18+ years old to bring in a guest. Each person with a membership is allowed up to 4 guests per a day. The fee is \$7 for youth (3-17) and seniors (60+), and \$9 for adults. Members are required to stay with their guests (ages 12 & under) throughout the entire duration of their visit.
