Important Guidelines:

- Only leaves will be collected—please do not include gumballs, branches, or other yard debris.
- Leaves must be raked and placed curbside by Sunday evening prior to your scheduled collection week.

East Area: Thursday, March 17

Central Area: Thursday, March 24

Annual Solid Waste Billing Begins March 1st, 2025

Annual Solid Waste Billing Begins March 1

University City residents should prepare for the upcoming solid waste services billing cycle, which begins March 1. This biannual billing covers trash, recycling, yard waste, and bulk item collection and is managed by the Finance Department.

Key Details:

- Billing occurs every six months, with statements issued in advance.
- Payments not received within 30 days of the billing date will be considered delinquent and subject to late fees.
- Senior citizens in single- or two-family homes may qualify for a discount if they meet eligibility requirements, including age and household size.

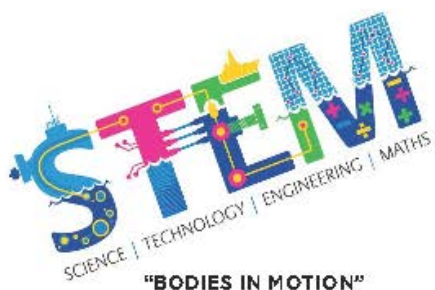

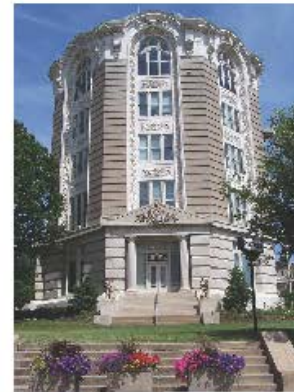
