Upcoming Changes to Solid Waste Refuse Rates – Effective April 1, 2025



University City to Implement Solid Waste Refuse Rate Increases Starting April 1, 2025

The University City Council has approved Bill 9565, which will introduce an 8.4% increase in solid waste refuse rates effective April 1, 2025. This change ensures the continued quality of waste collection services while addressing increasing operational costs. Beginning in March 2026, rates will also see an annual 3% increase based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI).

New Refuse Collection Rates (Effective April 1, 2025)

Residents and businesses should take note of the following updated rates:

- Single-family & two-family units (curb pickup, 90-gallon cart): \$19.50/month
- Single-family & two-family units (senior rate, 60-gallon cart): \$16.50/month
- Single-family & two-family units (alley mechanical box pickup): \$22.10/month
- Single-family & two-family units (senior rate, alley mechanical box pickup): \$18.67/month
- Multi-family (3+ units, curb pickup, 90-gallon cart): \$20.65/unit
- Multi-family (3+ units, alley mechanical box pickup): \$17.60/unit
- Multi-family (3+ units, mechanical box pickup & waste reduction): \$12.10/unit
- Public & private institutions: Rates determined based on service needs

Why the Increase?

The Solid Waste Rate Study Task Force recommended the increase after a detailed analysis of the city's waste collection costs. The additional revenue will help cover:

- ✓ Rising disposal and operational expenses
- ✓ Infrastructure upgrades for waste management
- ✓ Compliance with environmental regulations

What This Means for Residents & Businesses

Customers should review their utility bills and plan for the updated charges. Those looking to manage costs may consider waste reduction and recycling programs.

- Leaves must be raked and placed curbside by Sunday evening prior to your scheduled collection week.

East Area: Monday, March 17

Central Area: Monday, March 24

Protect & Serve: Public Safety Updates

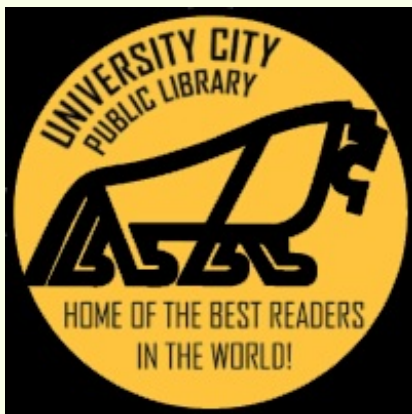
Detective Daur Nodari of the University City Police Department (UCPD) most recently delivered an informative Active Aggressor Response Training to the staff of Christ the King. The session included a detailed PowerPoint presentation, providing essential safety strategies. Prior to the training, Detective Nodari also conducted a security assessment of their new pre-K building to enhance preparedness measures.



With approximately 30 attendees, the training was well-received and ran smoothly. UCPD offers free active aggressor training and security audits to schools, religious institutions, and businesses throughout University City.

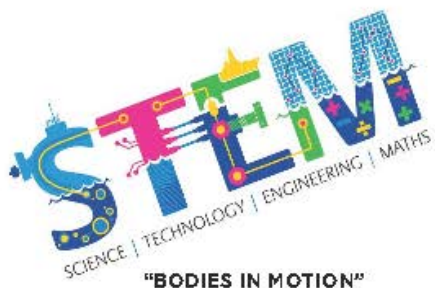
