Yard Waste Sticker Requirement Eliminated—Buy Back Program Announced

Following the passage of Bill No. 9564 on March 10, 2025, the University City Council has eliminated the requirement to place yard waste stickers on yard waste bags. This change updates Section 230.090 of the City's Municipal Code.

To support residents and businesses, the City has launched a Buy Back Program for unused stickers:

- If you have fewer than 66 stickers (valued at \$1.50 each), a credit will be applied to your refuse account.

- If you have 66 or more stickers, you'll receive a refund check.
- Businesses that purchased stickers for retail will also receive refund checks for their full purchase amount.

The Buy Back Program ENDS DECEMBER 31, 2025. Be sure to take advantage before the deadline!

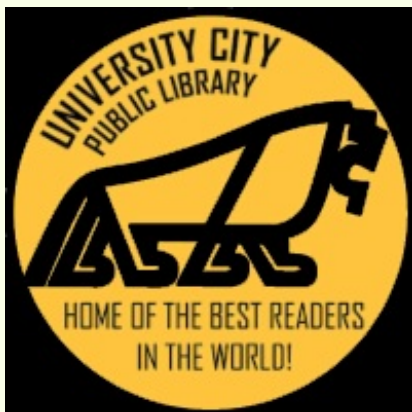

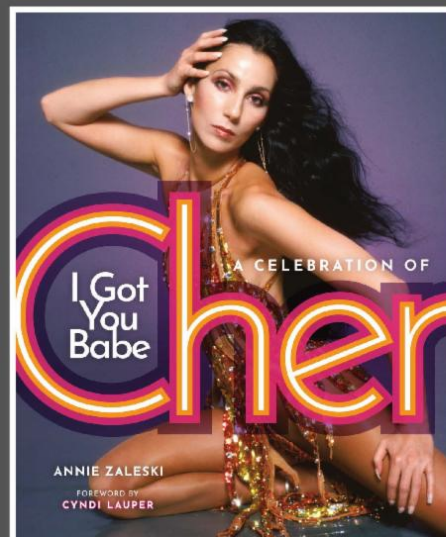
An evening with local author Annie Zaleski

Do you have old TVs, computers, routers, cell phones, cords, battery-operated electronics, or any other miscellaneous electronics laying around the house that you need to dispose of? University City will be hosting an electronics recycling drop-off event. This spring, we will only be offering the electronics recycling but stay tuned for a future document shredding event in the fall. The event is free for residents of St. Louis County only. The event is not open to businesses. Recycle up to two (2) monitors/TVs per vehicle at no charge*.

For other electronics, there are no limits on how many items you can recycle, and most items are free of charge. Visit ucitymo.org/recycling to see a full list of recyclable materials for this event. Questions? Call 314-505-8516.

*While funding allows. For more than two monitors or TVs, you will be charged \$30 for tube TVs or monitors; \$10 for flatscreen TVs or monitors.

The event is funded by a grant from Saint Louis County's Department of Public Health utilizing County landfill surcharge funds.

"Water Babies"

ages 6 mos. - 3 yrs.

Intended to develop comfort in and around water. Parent accompanies child in the pool.

Ratio: One Instructor/6 participants

Minimum: 4 Maximum 6 (per time period)

Time: 4:30 - 5:00 pm, 5:00 pm - 5:30, 5:30 - 6:00 pm or 6:00 - 6:30 pm

"Beginners"

ages 6 yrs. - 11 yrs.

Child learns elementary backstroke, kneeling dive and continue to work on front/back crawl. Sidestroke, Deep Water Bobbing, Breaststroke Kick are introduced as well as work on other strokes

Ratio: One Instructor/6 participants

Minimum: 4 Maximum 6 (per time period)

Time: 4:30 - 5:30 pm and 5:30 - 6:30 pm

"Non-Swimmers"

ages 3 yrs. - 8 yrs.

Teaches buoyancy, breath control and introduces basic water skills. Child learns unsupported floating, kicking and beginning swimming skills. Front and back crawl are introduced

Ratio: One Instructor/6 participants

Minimum: 4 Maximum 6 (per time period)

Time: 4:30 - 5:30 pm and 5:30 - 6:30 pm

"Adults"

ages 18 yrs. and Above

This is for a variety of levels. Levels of swim knowledge and experience will determine what lesson includes. The goal is to increase proficiency and knowledge of adults in this class

Ratio: One Instructor/6 participants

Minimum: 4 Maximum 6 (per time period)

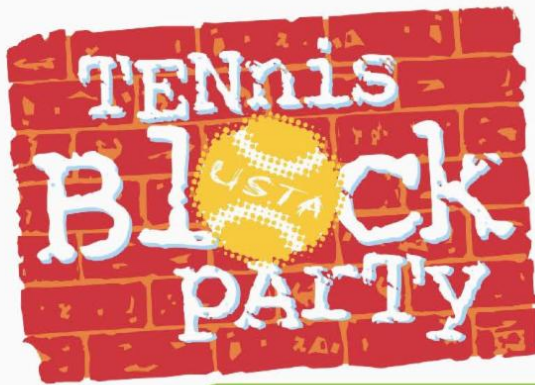

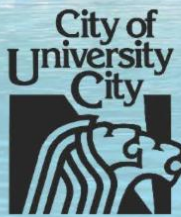

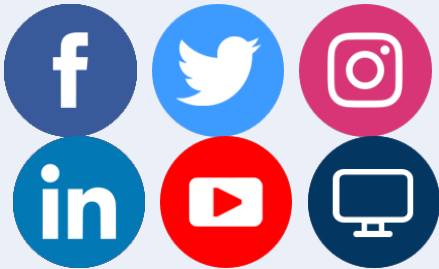
