

### REFUSE BILLING

Annual Billing for Solid Waste Services Begins Oct. 1 for Route Two. Solid waste (refuse) services, include trash, recycling, yard waste and bulk item collection. All services are billed in advance and statements are issued by the Finance Department in six-month cycles. Fees not paid 30 days after the beginning of the service period shall be considered delinquent or past due.
