



Leaf Collection Guidelines to Residents

To ensure prompt service, leaves must be raked to the curb line the Sunday before collection begins in your area. The East Section will start October 30th, the Central Section the following week and the West Section will be the week afterwards. 


Dear Community Member:

As the holiday season approaches, we are reminded of the spirit of giving and the joy of coming together as a community. It is with great hope and enthusiasm that I reach out to you today, as we launch our annual holiday appeal. During this special time of year, we are asking for your help to continue this vital work and make the holidays brighter for countless families.

Last year, we were able to help 104 families with 264 children in our school district. A typical "adopted" family received a personal hygiene basket, gift card for groceries, laundry soap, toys or activities, and gift cards to buy clothing or other gifts for their children.

Once again, the social workers are requesting donations of gift cards to help families purchase their own holiday presents:

> gift cards to Schneiders, Aldi's, Walmart, Target, Walgreens, or Old Navy

> Visa or MasterCard gift cards

The goal is to help families by giving each child at least \$20 in gift cards and \$100 in grocery gift cards for the household. The University City Fire Department and several local churches collaborate with us to provide additional toys, activities and hygiene supplies for our families. Families have the opportunity to "shop" for additional toys and items when they pick up their gift cards.

The District's goal is for the requested donations be available by December 1 to help ensure the families have time to buy their gifts for the holidays.
