## How to Report a Streetlight Issue in University City

University City is committed to keeping our streets safe, accessible, and well-lit for residents and visitors alike. With more than 4,000 streetlights citywide, maintaining that level of service is truly a shared responsibility—and your help makes a difference.

Approximately 750 of these lights are maintained by the University City Public Works Department. The remaining lights—about 98% of residential streetlights—are owned and maintained by Ameren Missouri.

If you notice a streetlight that is out, flashing, or damaged, here's how you can

identify the correct owner and report it promptly:

## 1. Identify the Streetlight Type

- Ameren Missouri-owned: Look for a tag on the pole that begins with a “U” followed by numbers (e.g., U306).
- Private Property Lights: Tags beginning with a “Z” indicate private ownership—these lights were installed by request.
- University City-owned: Lights without tags are typically maintained by University City.

## 2. Reporting a Streetlight Issue

- For Ameren Missouri-owned lights:

Call **314-342-1000** and provide:

- Exact address and side of the street
- Streetlight ID number (if visible) or a detailed description of the location
- Your name and contact number
- Description of the issue (e.g., out, flickering, damaged)
- Whether the light was damaged by an accident

### For University City-maintained lights:

Contact the Public Works Department at **314-505-8560**.  
(Provide the address, location, any identifying details, and your contact information.)

The University City Police Department is proud to partner with St. Louis BWorks to host a free 6-week Earn-A-Bike program for youth ages 8 to 17. Held at the Heman Park Community Center, this hands-on workshop teaches bicycle safety, basic maintenance, and essential riding skills.

Each student will have the opportunity to completely rebuild a donated bicycle and—upon successful completion of all six sessions—will receive:

- A refurbished bicycle
- A new helmet

- A bike light set and lock

The program culminates in a celebratory group ride through Heman Park, allowing participants to practice their new skills in a fun and supportive environment.

## **Century Home Honor Celebrates Frank Rand House in University City**

On Sunday, July 13, 2025, the City of University City proudly joined the Historical Society of University City to honor one of its architectural treasures — The Frank Rand House, located at 7100 Delmar Boulevard — with an official Century Home Plaque presentation.

Hosted by Mayor Terry Crow, with a nod to the home's original architect, Theodore C. Link (in spirit), the event celebrated over a century of historical and architectural significance. Guests were treated to a special video presentation that highlighted the home's rich legacy and the story it tells as part of the vibrant Link District.

The Frank Rand House is now among more than 150 homes in University City recognized through the Century Home Program, which honors residential structures that have stood for 100 years or more. The program, organized by the Historical Society of University City, helps preserve the unique history of our neighborhoods by providing bronze plaques to qualifying homes.

# 2025 Swim Instruction

### "Water Babies"

ages 6 mos. - 3 yrs.

Intended to develop comfort in and around water. Parent accompanies child in the pool.

Ratio: One Instructor/6 participants

Minimum: 4 Maximum 6 (per time period)

Time: 4:30 - 5:00 pm, 5:00 pm - 5:30,  
5:30 - 6:00 pm or 6:00 - 6:30 pm

### "Beginners"

ages 6 yrs. - 11 yrs.

Child learns elementary backstroke, kneeling dive and continue to work on front/back crawl. Sidestroke, Deep Water Bobbing, Breaststroke Kick are introduced as well as work on other strokes

Ratio: One Instructor/6 participants

Minimum: 4 Maximum 6 (per time period)

Time: 4:30 - 5:30 pm and 5:30 - 6:30 pm

### "Non-Swimmers"

ages 3 yrs. - 8 yrs.

Teaches buoyancy, breath control and introduces basic water skills. Child learns unsupported floating, kicking and beginning swimming skills. Front and back crawl are introduced

Ratio: One Instructor/6 participants

Minimum: 4 Maximum 6 (per time period)

Time: 4:30 - 5:30 pm and 5:30 - 6:30 pm

### "Adults"

ages 18 yrs. and Above

This is for a variety of levels. Levels of swim knowledge and experience will determine what lesson includes. The goal is to increase proficiency and knowledge of adults in this class

Ratio: One Instructor/6 participants

Minimum: 4 Maximum 6 (per time period)

Time: 4:30 - 5:30 pm and 5:30 - 6:30 pm

### Tuesdays and Thursdays

Session I: June 3 - June 26

Session II: July 8 - July 31

Make Up Day: Fridays (only due to weather related cancellations)

Fee: Resident - \$40/person Nonresident - \$50/person
