University City Eliminates Yard Waste Sticker Requirement for Residents

UNIVERSITY CITY, Mo. – The City of University City is pleased to announce that, effective March 11, 2025, residents are no longer required to purchase yard waste stickers for yard waste collection. This change follows the passage of a new ordinance by the City Council at its meeting on March 10, 2025.

The removal of the yard waste sticker requirement is part of the City's ongoing efforts to streamline waste collection services and reduce costs for residents. Residents can continue to place yard waste at the curb in accordance with existing collection guidelines.

"We are committed to making waste disposal more convenient for our community," said City Manager, Gregory Rose. "By eliminating the sticker requirement, we're removing an extra step for residents while maintaining the same high level of service."
