University City Announces Start of Pershing Avenue Improvement Project

UNIVERSITY CITY, Mo. – University City is beginning construction on the Pershing Avenue Sidewalk Improvements Project (STP-5402(620)) on **Monday, November 10, 2025**. M&H Concrete Contractors, Inc. will lead the work, beginning with saw-cutting and sidewalk removal along the **east side of Pershing Avenue, near Forest Park**.

The project includes new sidewalks, ADA accessibility upgrades, roadway resurfacing, and general utility improvements. Initial concrete work will continue through the winter as weather allows, followed by roadway and restoration work in spring and summer 2026.

Residents are asked to:

- Avoid parking near marked construction zones.
- Move vehicles out of driveways before work begins each day.
- Mark any sprinkler systems or dog fences near the curb.
- Expect brief delays (2–5 minutes) during active work hours (7:00 a.m.–4:30 p.m.).

Access to driveways and garages may be temporarily restricted, and street slabs will be barricaded for up to seven days after replacement to allow proper curing. M&H Concrete will notify affected residents prior to blocking driveways. Emergency vehicles and school buses will always be given immediate access.
