COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE PROCESS NOW UNDERWAY CITY RECRUITING VOLUNTEERS TO ASSIST WITH THE EFFORT

A Comprehensive Plan is a long-term vision for a community, collaboratively developed by residents, business and property owners, and many other stakeholders. It can focus on a number of issue areas that are important to the community such as housing and neighborhoods, land use and redevelopment, transportation and parking, and sustainability -- just to name a few. University City's comprehensive plan was last updated in 2005. Though not mandated by the City's Charter, State Statute or other ordinance, it is good practice to update the document periodically to reflect changes to social, economic and physical conditions. The City is initiating just such an effort -- and we need your help.

A Comprehensive Plan Advisory Committee (CPAC) is being formed to guide and support the process. The CPAC will consist of individuals from throughout the City representing a cross-section of backgrounds and interests. The CPAC will work with City staff, a team of consultants and the City's Plan Commission on the 18 to 24 month long planning process. While a meeting schedule has not yet been established for the CPAC, members should expect to attend multiple meetings over the life span of the process, review materials, meet with the consultant team and attend public workshops and meetings.
